NEW Exhibitor Pass Process

Please share this with ALL of your booth workers!

Greetings, Exhibitors!

Our Exhibitor Pass Process has been revised for the 2012 Expo. Please share this document with all your booth workers prior to the Expo.

1. Your booth workers will need to check in at the Exhibitor check-in booth, located outside the Main Expo gate.
2. When they check in, they will sign for an exhibitor pass, located in your folder and stored at the Exhibitor check-in booth.
3. After they have received their pass, they will head to the Main Expo gate where their pass will be collected by the Granite State Ambassador (GSA) watching the gate.
4. The GSA will stamp your booth worker's hand and then the worker will be able to come and go from the Main Expo gate as needed.
5. Should a booth worker be working in your booth on both Friday and Saturday during the Expo, they will repeat the same process as listed above on Saturday.
6. Once all passes have been signed for, if there are booth workers who need a pass, they must purchase a regular-priced admission ticket of \$7.
