NOTED HORTICULTURIST TO PRESENT AT 2009 NH FARM AND FOREST EXPO

CONCORD, NH — New Hampshire horticulturist Margaret Hagen, Extension Educator of Agricultural Resources at the University of New Hampshire Cooperative Extension in Hillsborough County, will lead a session on container growing as part of a “Garden Workshop” on Saturday, February 7 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the NH Farm and Forest Exposition at Manchester’s Radisson Hotel/Center of NH.

Known for her weekly appearances on the WMUR-TV Channel 9 news segment “Grow It Green”, Ms. Hagen also conveys practical horticultural information to the general public through lectures, workshops, and occasional newspaper articles.
