### CHAMPION GIANT PUMPKIN GROWER TO PRESENT AT 2009 NH FARM AND FOREST EXPO

CONCORD, NH — Jim Beauchemin, 2005 New England Champion Giant Pumpkin Grower, will present “Growing Giant Pumpkins” at 9 a.m. on Saturday, February 7 at the NH Farm and Forest Exposition at Manchester’s Radisson Hotel/Center of NH.

Mr. Beauchemin states, “Growing giant pumpkins has become a tremendous way for commercial vegetable growers to draw attention to their roadside farm stands.
