CONCORD, NH — UNH Cooperative Extension and the NH Winery Association will present “Intermediate Winemaking: Making Better Wines” Saturday, February 6 from 9 a.m. to 12 noon at the 2010 NH Farm and Forest Exposition, to be held at Manchester’s Radisson Hotel/Center of NH.

This session, for small to medium-scale winemakers or the advanced hobbyist, focuses on tools and techniques to make high-quality wines from wine chemistry analysis and micro-biology to wine maturation and cellaring. Tips to solve common winemaking challenges will be exchanged. A \$20 session fee will be collected at the door and used to defray speaker costs.
