CHAMPION GIANT PUMPKIN GROWER TO PRESENT AT 2010 NH FARM AND FOREST EXPO

CONCORD, NH — Jim Beauchemin, 2005 New England Champion Giant Pumpkin Grower, will present “The Secret to Growing Giant Pumpkins” at 9 a.m. on Saturday, February 6 at the NH Farm and Forest Exposition at Manchester’s Radisson Hotel/Center of NH.

Mr. Beauchemin states, “Growing giant pumpkins has become a tremendous way for commercial vegetable growers to draw attention to their roadside farm stands. During the seminar we will take attendees from beginning to end of all aspects of growing giant pumpkins. Also, free seeds and tip sheets will be handed out to all those who participate in the workshop.”

While education sessions at the Expo are free, admission to the Expo Floor with commercial and educational exhibitors for \$7 for adults (\$6 with 2 non-perishable food items to benefit the NH Food Bank), while children 15 and under is free.

The New Hampshire Farm & Forest Exposition provides information and education on all aspects of agriculture and forestry. Each year, the Expo brings the state’s farming and forestry communities together to share ideas and views on industry needs, while providing a fun and interesting venue for the public to learn about these industries and their impact on life in New Hampshire.
