CONCORD, NH — Margaret Hagen, director of the Family, Home & Garden Education Center for the UNH Cooperative Extension, will present “Environmentally-Friendly Lawn Care” Saturday, February 5th at 9:15 a.m. during the 28th annual NH Farm and Forest Expo at the Radisson/Center of New Hampshire in Manchester. Gardner’s presentation will be in the Webster Room.
